## **Apologies**

- 1. KH introduced the new members. **K**H is to circulate the minutes of the last meeting which had not reached everyone.
- 2. <u>Development</u> The practice has two new permanent GPs. VP & KH have reallocated patients to the new GPs' lists and intend to advertise for a further GP.
- 3. RW reported that his wife had had difficulty contacting the practice on Friday (12<sup>th</sup>) afternoon. KH explained that they only had two reception staff available with one handling visitors and the other handling all the phone calls hence the delay.
  - Training is being given to the Receptionist team to ensure they are able to handle emergencies such as Chest Pains or Breathing Difficulties correctly.
- 4. The garden team is getting ready to dig the allotments, and the 16-25 year olds had a bird watching session on 10/11<sup>th.</sup> Texts are being sent to invite further patients.
- 5. KH explained that e-consult switched on at 8.30 and could only be used when the practice is open. It is planned to revamp the Practice Website.

- 6. The case was raised of an 89 year old patient who had been called up for a blood test which he found stressful. He was seen by two unsupervised Medical Students who took the sample, but failed to ensure the was calm and relaxed.
- 7. AH said he was switching from getting his repeat prescriptions from ASDA to a local pharmacy because of delays at the former.
- 8. SH thought there was a need for a 'dummy's' guide to e-consult and prescription ordering. He also asked why he was unable to get a non-urgent appointment from the Receptionists & KH explained this was due to government regulations.
- 9. RD asked whether it was possible to email a specific GP, & was told this was only possible on an individual basis because of the flood of texts that would otherwise result.
- 10. KH said the practice now had two physiotherapists who could assess new problems and then refer patients on as appropriate.
